Dear Sir / Madam,

hereby MIXA S.r.l. (hereinafter for brevity "Mixa"), TIN . and VAT number 01951910221, registration number PD - 367839, with registered office in 32502 Ponte San Nicolò, Viale Svezia n. 4, CEM: innmed@pec.it, as Controller of your personal data, provides you, in accordance and for the purposes of art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter, "GDPR"), the following information.

PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

- a) Managing pre-contractual relationships (quotes-offers);
- b) Managing the fulfillment of the contract;
- c) Fulfillments imposed on the Controller deriving from legal obligations, regulations, community legislation, provisions given by appointed authorities or by supervisory and control bodies;
- d) protecting the rights of the Controller in the event of disputes arising from the contractual - precontractual relationship (in court or elsewhere, in line with the law);
- e) sending of advertising material (paper, newsletters, messages ...).

The legal basis of the processing, for the above mentioned purposes, is made up of:

- a) contract and pre- contractual measures - art. 6.1 b) GDPR;
- b) legal obligations - art. 6.1 c) GDPR;
- c) legitimate interest of the Data Controller as indicated above in letter d) - art. 6.1 f) GDPR;
- d) consent of the interested party - art. 6.1 a) GDPR.

If the Controller intends to further process personal data for a purpose other than that for which they are have been collected, before such further processing, the interested party will be provided with information regarding such different purpose and each further relevant information, asking for your consent if necessary.

DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your personal data will be retained for the period necessary to execute the service and subsequently for the time required by law, as well as up to the limitation period of any reciprocal rights arising from the contract.

The data needed to send advertising material will be retained until the possible revocation of the interested party or the eventual deadline set by sector legislation.

NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND DENIAL CONSEQUENCES

The provision of data is elective with the exception of those that you commit to provide contractually or that you must provide by law; therefore any refusal to provide them, in whole or in part, may make it impossible for the Controller to perform your requests.

PROCESSING METHODS

Your personal data will be processed both manually and through the use of computer tools, with appropriate way and means to ensure maximum security and confidentiality.

CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS

For the above mentioned purposes, your personal data will be processed by Mixa staff specifically authorized in relation to their respective jobs and according to the profiles attributed to them, and also communicated:

- to private individuals and / or subsidiaries performing activities and services on behalf of Mixa designated as external managers of the data processing pursuant to art. 28 of the GDPR (such as, by way of example and not limited to: legal professionals, company for the transmission of communications, etc.);
- to private subjects performing activities and services in the name and on behalf of Mixa as external agents;
- to subjects who perform supervisory functions (eg SB) or to certifying bodies if necessary.

Your personal data will not be disclosed nor will undergo decision-making processes aimed at profiling.

DATA TRANSFER TO A THIRD COUNTRY AND / OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION

Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries outside the European Union.

RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

The interested party has the right to ask Mixa:

- to access personal data and to correct them if they are inaccurate, to cancel them or limit their processing if the prerequisites occur, or to object their processing;
- the portability of data in the cases provided for by the regulation;
- to revoke the consent at any time without compromising the lawfulness of the processing carried out before the revocation.

The above mentioned rights may be asserted by the interested party by submitting a specific request to the Data Controller at the following e-mail address: commerciale@mixaconsulting.it.

Lastly, in the event that the interested party believes that the processing that concerns him or her violates the EU Regulation 2016/679, the latter has right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority in accordance with art. 77 GDPR, or take any legal actions in the judicial offices
